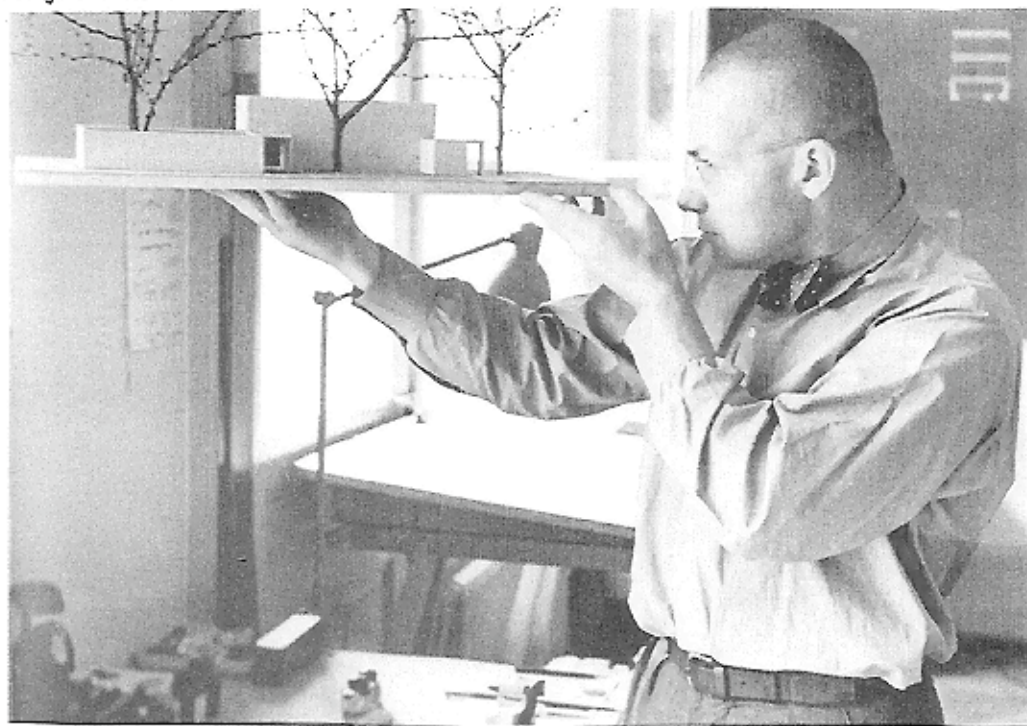

Alan Fowler is an Art historian with a specialist interest in constructivist art and design (using the term in its broadest sense) and will briefly outline Bill's career looking at his painting, sculpture and graphic & product design. He will also refer to his influence on two groups of English Artists (the 1950/60 Constructionists (sic) and the 1970's Systems group) and to Bill's role in developing the Swiss style of graphic design and Typography which was reflected in several examples of British graphic Design in the 1960's.

Philip Boyle is an Architect and will talk about Bill's design for Hochschule für Gestaltung in Ulm, arguably his most famous work of Architecture, and discuss the relationship between this and the work of the British architects Alison and Peter Smithson at the University of Bath.
